Access iPhone contacts from your Mac or PC

Almost all features of Air Contacts (except of mailing contacts) need an active WiFi Connection for working properly.



When starting up the App an IP Address will be shown to you. If you are not connected to a network, a message will warn you, that no WiFi connection is available.

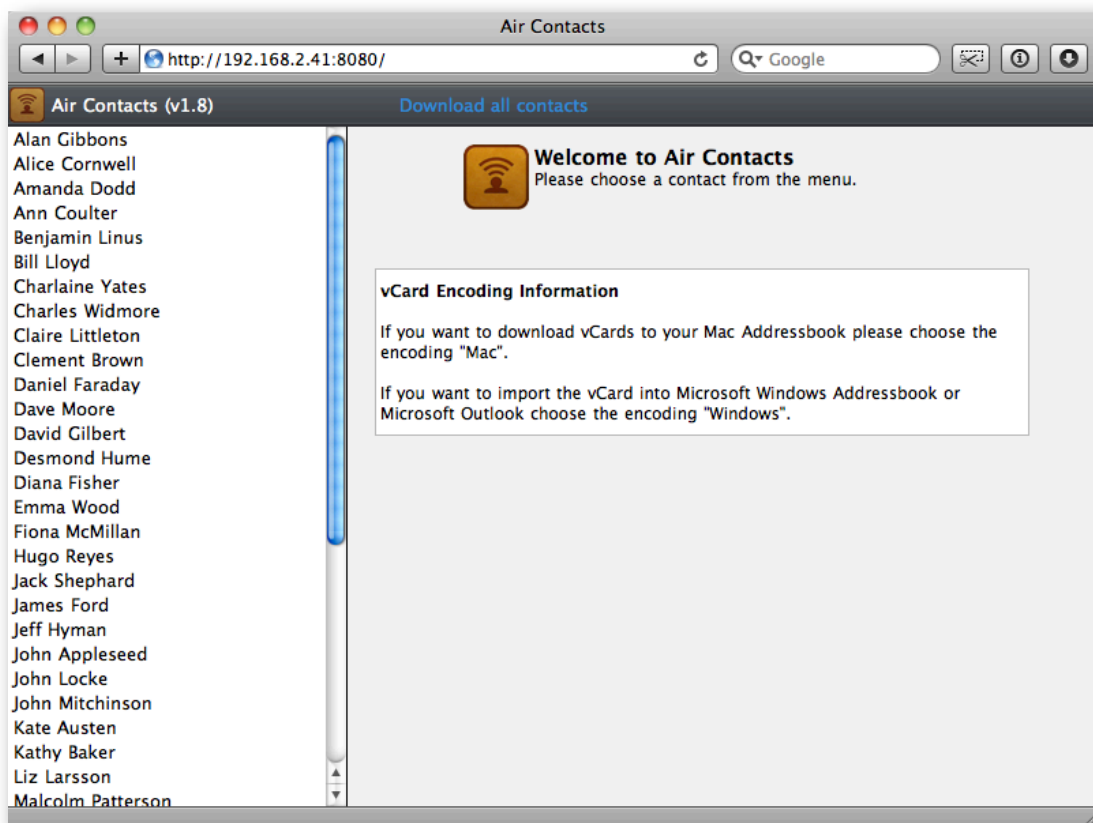
On the bottom bar there are buttons to stop/start the built-in webserver, to send contacts by mail, to connect to other devices and to show up the settings.

Now start up a webbrowser on your PC or Mac, which is part of the same local network your iPhone is in.

Enter the displayed address (including the port number :8080) in your browser.

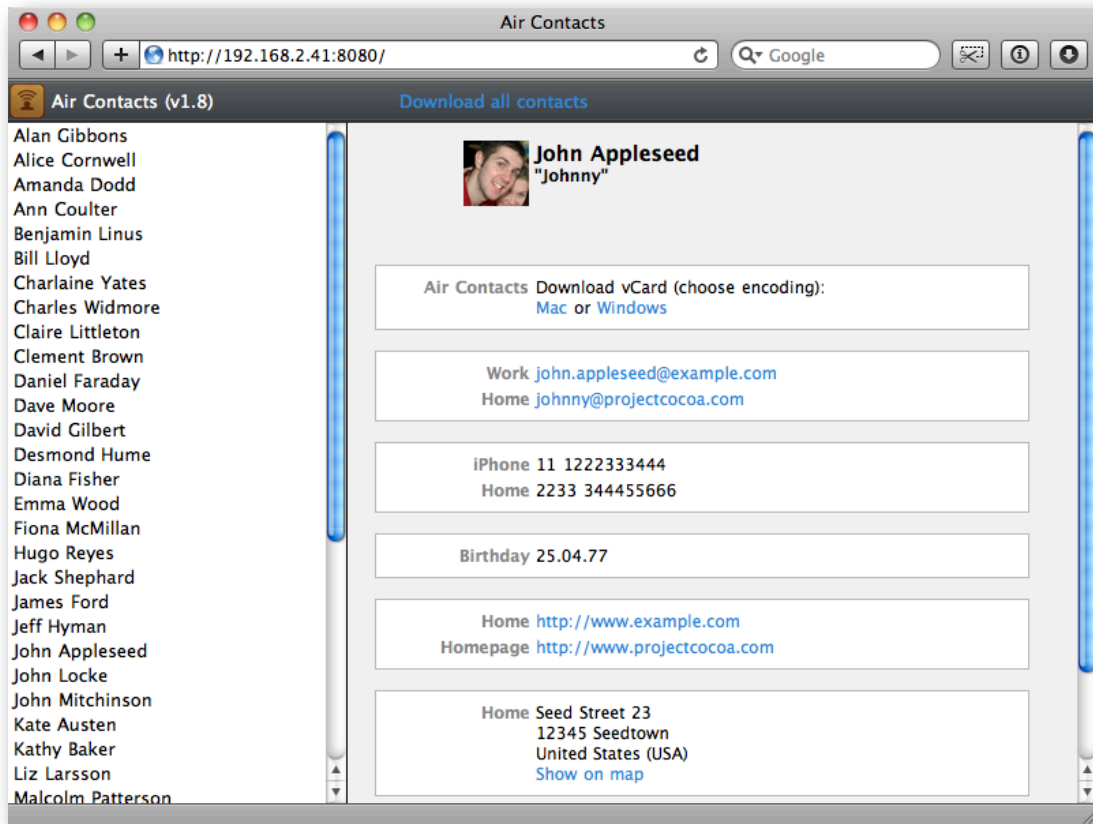
Example for a typical address: `http://192.168.2.41:8080`

The startpage of Air Contacts will appear:



Browsing Contacts

Viewing details of the shared contacts is done by clicking the contact name on the left side of the webpage.



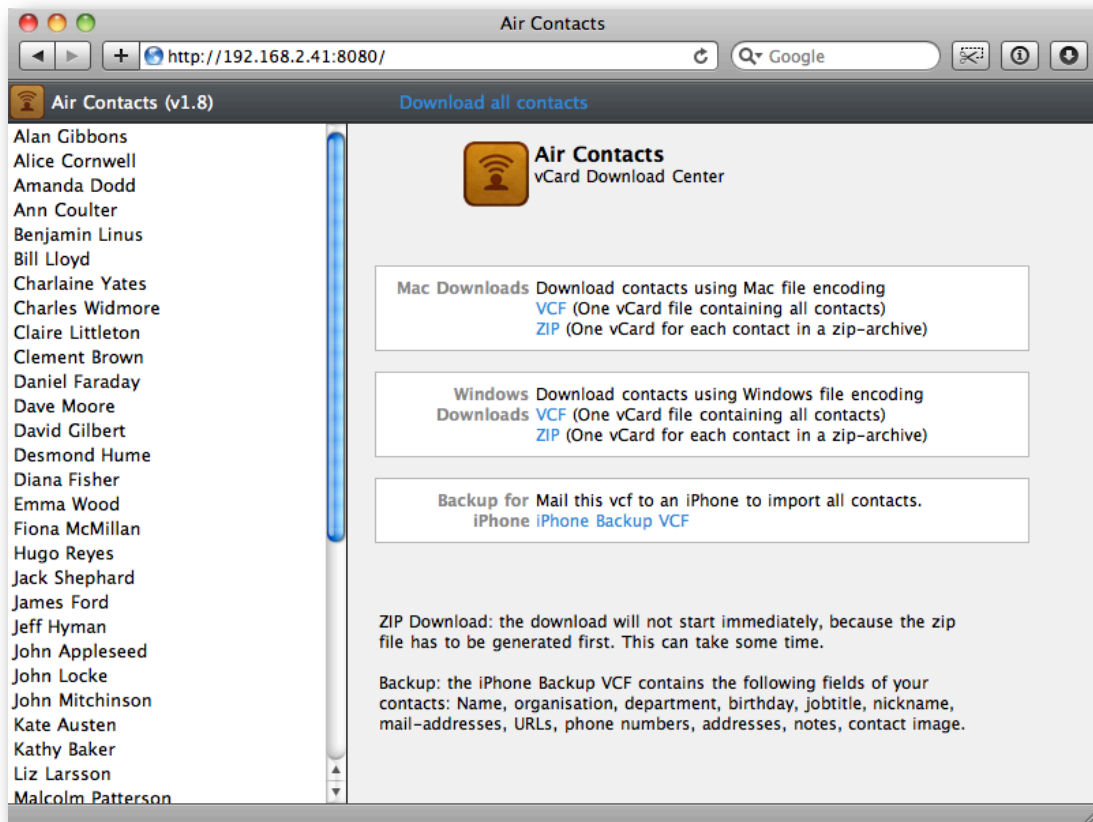
Air Contacts shows you all properties of your selected contact.

If you do not want to share all properties you can change this in the settings view of the App.

Air Contacts also gives you the possibility to download a contact. Choose the format which best matches your system: Mac or Windows. This download is a vCard (vcf), which can easily be imported into the addressbook application of your system.

vCard Download Center

By clicking the link „Download all contacts“ (can be found in the top bar of the website) you will get to the vCard Download Center:



Here you can download all shared contacts within one file! You have several types to choose from:

- VCF: This file is a single vcf file containing all contacts.
- ZIP: This file is Zip-Archive which contains one vcf file for each shared contact
- Backup for iPhone: this is an iPhone contact backup file.

VCF and ZIP downloads are available for Mac and Windows systems.

Backup and restore of iPhone contacts

Backup Contacts

1. Download the „Backup for iPhone“ file from the vCard Download Center
2. Store this file at a save location

Restore Contacts

1. Start a new E-Mail
2. Attach the backup vcf file to the mail
3. Send the mail to an account which you can access using the iPhone Mail App
4. Open Mail App on the iPhone and view the mail you sent to your account
5. Touch the attachment
6. Touch „Add All XX Contacts“
7. Now all the contacts from within the backup file will be imported to your iPhone addressbook



Connect to other devices running Air Contacts



By tapping this button you get to the device browser. Here you can select the devices you want to connect. Now you can upload and download contacts to and from the connected device.
